i. Questions purposed by executive committee:

• What role do you see AP Council playing in the shared governance culture at ISU? Is it possible to expand that role? The university must rely on the AP council as the year goes on and as the budget impasse continues. Most state universities will see their tuition dollars run out later this month. AP's roll will become more defined as the year continues and the budget issues continues to unfold. Shared governance is a hallmark on ISU's campus. Suggestion would be to formally ask senate for more balanced representation around the table at the Academic Senate. Encouraging advocacy amongst AP's, BOT's and other AP council's throughout the other 11 state institutions. Jonathon Lackland could assist with who at the other universities are doing the advocacy work.

What can AP Council members do to foster inter-departmental and inter-division collegiality?
