### **Business**

### A/P Salary Enhancement Study

Mangialardi and Vegter attended a meeting of the group that is working to establish A/P salary comparisons for the purposes of A/P staff participation in the ongoing salary enhancement program. They shared the following information from that meeting:

- Roughly 50% of A/P positions have been benchmarked at this point
- Concerns were raised as to why this process continues to be identified as difficult, and thus a hindrance to A/P staff participation

- There has been some difficulty identified in achieving a balance between finding legitimate, viable information, and completing the research in a timely manner
- Main concern would be to make certain that the information and the data used to make these decisions is as accurate as possible
- The President has charged the group with completing the study within the spring semester, with applicable enhancements being retroactive to January '06.

### Board of Trustees/Campus Communications Committee meeting

As the current Chair of the CCC, Mangialardi provided the following comments:

- The CCC has received the agenda for the February 17 Board of Trustees meeting, and will meet now to determine how they want to address the issues being discussed
- A letter will be drafted, and read publicly to the BOT at their meeting
- The CCC will also be meeting with President Bowman prior to the BOT meeting to engage in some discussion regarding the contents of the letter
- One issue to be addressed may include concerns about the replacement of reserve monies being targeted to replace the turf at Hancock Stadium, given that (through a previous BOT decision) student fees were frozen last year
