Chair's remarks – Mboka met with President Bowman and discussed the various searches that are currently in progress. The Assistant Vice President for Human Resources has been named. The Vice President of University Advancement is underway with the goal of a May 1 start date. Dr. Bowman is still positive about Illinois State's budget for next year, with a possible tuition increase being possible. It is still on the table for Milner Library to receive monies for planning. He is also glad that Illinois State received approval to borrow monies, if needed. Lastly, he was pleased to see the enrollment deposits are ahead of last year's at this time.

- Academic Senate Ron Gifford Senate met last night (3/24/10). Lane Crothers presented. Dr. Bowman spoke about state funding and addressed some untrue rumors about layoffs of faculty members. Dr. Everts presented information about our incoming students (ACT has increased, underrepresented populations has increased, numbers have increased). She also made mention of the Associate Provost position that is currently posted. Mr. Adams mentioned the replacement of the Daily Vidette editor; 42 cases of H1N1 have been reported for this semester; and the Career Center Director search is currently underway. Dr. Layzell announced the AVP of HR and that the KNR building is currently on schedule.
