#### MINUTES

#### **Chair's Remarks:**

- President Search-Amelia Noel-Elkins and Susan Woollen updated the Council in regards • to the Presidential search. A meeting is scheduled for May 7<sup>th</sup> for the Search Committee to discuss and then make its final recommendation to the Board of Trustees. At this time, both Amelia and Susan are unsure if this meeting will involve the entire Search Committee or just the Executive Committee. Amelia informed the Council that the level of research done by the search firm was excellent and various issues had been thoroughly researched prior to candidates coming to campus. The question was asked if President Bowman had any input on the candidates. Amelia and Susan responded that President Bowman was part of the interview process as all candidates meet with him at the end of their day on campus. Also, President Bowman has the same opportunity to provide feedback as the rest of the campus on the provided evaluation forms. These forms are being compiled by Jackie Snelling. Council members asked what role Amelia and Susan had in the search. Both ladies were involved with reviewing all applications in April. They took part in the initial discussion and were involved in the initial and middle rounds of discussion and selection. It was asked if Bob Dobski and Joanne Maitland were involved in the search process as their tenure on the Board was not renewed by Governor Quinn. Both participated in the search process and were part of the Executive Committee but will not be involved in the final vote. It was also mentioned that as of right now, the projected starting date for the new president will be July 1<sup>st</sup>. Both Amelia and Susan thanked the Council for allowing them to represent the AP community on the Search Committee.
- Presidential Candidate Interviews-Stacy thanked Council members for their attendance at the previous candidate forums. AP Council was well-represented. Some Council members will have a scheduling conflict on Monday and will not be able to make the Shared Governance Forum for Dr. Dietz.
