Guest – Julie Prianos, IWSS re: new ISU Homepage: Julie visited with Council members and went through a demo of the beta version of the ISU Homepage and requested feedback. IWSS has been working on this project since last spring. A committee has been established for review of the homepage consisting of representation from Student Affairs, Finance & Planning, EMAS, and University Advancement. The desired outcome was to streamline the site to serve an external audience and serve as the front door to the University. They will be working on an employee intranet in the future. The search feature has also been improved showing top searches and related searches. The go live date is currently slated for end of September.

Chair's remarks –Stacy met with President today and noted that enrollment numbers look good and referenced the article in the paper noting that the Governor is making cuts in the budget, but said those will not likely affect the University. The State of the University Address is September 27th, please attend. Stacy also noted that she serves on the Capital Planning and Budget Team which met earlier in the week and discussed items on campus including: a reconditioning of space at Student Health Services, Cardinal Court is ahead of schedule, Watterson is on schedule, new paint and carpeting are planned for Milner Library, the broadband network (which is funded by the largest grant ISU has ever received), the bleachers were removed in the south end-zone due to a safety issue, and the grand opening of the MCN lab is next week. The capital improvements list sent to the BOT for approval includes Milner, MCN, COE (DeGarmo & Metcalf), Uhigh, and Williams Hall. Work on the Capen and Femley Hall heating system will be expedited once funding is released from Springfield.
