University Policy Committee:
 - Reviewed a new markup for Policy 3.2.9 Leave without Pay. This came back to us from Janice Bonneville based on her meeting with us last time. We as a committee, however, had even more questions and are asking her back to clarify as that will be faster and more efficient than trying to get those answered in back-and-forth emails.
 - Reviewed updates to Policy 6.1.13 Amplification. Most of the updates were language. However, some updates led to questions, such as this now seems to be more about sound/noise issues and not so much amplified sound. We are reaching out again to gain some clarity on these changes.
